Easing of Covid Restrictions – Worship at St Margaret's

Full seating has been reinstated in the nave. Although there is no seating plan, please be considerate of others when choosing your seat and in maintaining social distance, and use the whole of the church. Stewards will be available to help seat you, if required.

- Offering the sign of Peace in a non-physical manner. There will be no physical offertory the collection plate will be at the back of church.

It is particularly important that, if you have any cold or flu-like symptoms or feel unwell in any way, you do not attend church that week as a courtesy to other worshippers.

Church Opening Hours

St Margaret's is open from 9.30am - 4.00pm daily for private prayer and reflection (except Sunday mornings). You are welcome to visit church at a time that suits you.

We ask you to continue to observe covid safe practices when you enter church. Please use hand sanitizer when you enter and leave church and take responsibility for your own social distancing. Although it is no longer a legal requirement to sign in we encourage you to scan the NHS QR code or sign in on the sheet provided. We have also kept the "Please clean me" notices for you to pick up on entering church. We kindly ask you to leave this notice on your seat when you leave church.
