We shall sing evensong at 3.00 pm, having travelled to Carlisle on the spectacular Settle-Carlisle railway, have lunch either packed or at a cafe in the city, before rehearsing from 1.45 pm to 2.45 pm. The service includes my responses (unusually accompanied on the organ) and psalm 118; the canticles are sung to Stanford's setting in G, with Leo Lord-Cloke singing the soprano solo in the Magnificat, and, hopefully, Tom Ashby the baritone solo in the Nunc Dimittis. We finish the service with the Peter Aston anthem (I am the true vine) which we shall sing here on St Margaret's Day. I am reminded that 50 years ago I served as Assistant Organist at Carlisle - it seems like yesterday! Christopher
